Farm Labor Housing Direct Loans & Grants

Are you having troubles finding housing for your farm or ranch employees? Why

don't you check out USDA's financing program to develop housing for year-round and migrant or seasonal domestic farm laborers.

Who may apply for this program? This program assists qualified applicants that cannot obtain commercial credit on terms that will allow them to charge rents that are affordable to low-income tenants. Qualified applicants include:

- Farmers, associations of farmers and family farm corporations
- Associations of farm workers and non-profit organizations
- Most State and local governmental entities
- Federally-recognized Tribes

What is an eligible area? Housing may be constructed in urban or rural areas, as long as there is a demonstrated need.

How many funds be used? Construction, improvement, repair and purchase of housing for domestic farm laborers is the primary objective of this program.

What kinds of funding are available?

- Low interest loans
- Grants based on need and may not exceed 90% of project cost
