Home Rehab Funds Coming to Burwell and Valentine

The Central Nebraska Housing and Economic Developers have received notice from the State of Nebraska regarding an award of funds to repair owner-occupied homes in Burwell and Valentine. The \$250,000 grant will enable CNHED to loan funds to income-eligible households to address housing quality, weatherization and energy efficiency, and accessibility and other home repair needs in both communities. Funds are provided through the Nebraska Affordable Housing Trust Fund.
