2018 Grants Awarded

KBR Sanitation - \$16,000 – Recycling Equipment; City of Ainsworth - \$385,000 for Sewer Improvements; City of Atkinson - \$295,000 for Rental Duplex Construction; City of Ord - \$247,500 for Gap Street Paving, Valentine and O'Neill - \$480,780 for Workforce Housing Construction and Rehabilitation, City of O'Neill \$252,000 for Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation.
