FCC National Broadband Map



Step 1: Go the FCC's National Broadband Map at: <u>https://broadbandmap.fcc.gov/</u> <u>home</u> and enter an address in the "location" box.

Step 2: If you see the location of buildings/facilities, click on the dot. IF **green**, can providers serve that location. IF **grey**, and you believe the location should be able to receive broadband, or there is no dot, click on <u>"Location Challenge"</u>.

Step 3: Once you have clicked on 'Location Challenge', there will be a place for you to fill out your information. Before submitting, make sure to *scroll down to the bottom* to fill out all the information requested.
